Additional Airport Information via AC-U-Kwik integration

- - Airport details (including: name, location, runway length, type, codes)
- - Communication Information
- - Contact information
- - Restriction information
- - ATC controls
- - Handlers
- - Fueling services
- - Suppliers
- - Hotel options

All reports include information relevant to that airport, therefore the data present will change per report and not all airports have operational data available.

The report lists the 3 most relevant areas of focus for the given airport and the 5 most recent pings.

Note: All reports can be found in the 'Archive' section (under the reports tab) of the platform once run. However, a new report needs to be produced if you need to risk assess the same area again.

How to view and generate airport reports

1. Click the **Reports** option down the left-hand side of the page
2. Choose the risk type view using the tick box option or search for an airport (IATA/ICAO codes).
3. Click on the searched airport to show the overview modal, providing activity in the last 6 months and the risk rating of that area
4. To have AC-U-Kwik data included in the report select 'Standard + Operational Airport Report'
5. Click the **Report** button to generate an automatic, instant risk report of the selected area

How to change your default template

1. Go to **Reports > templates** option down the left-hand side of the page (you can also view/edit all your templates here)
2. Select **'Standard + Operational Airport Report'** from the Available Templates dropdown
3. Tick box **'default template'** to make it the default for all your airport reports
4. If you wish to amend the template configuration choose the desired elements from the tick box options in the **'selected report elements'** section
5. Click **save** (the template will now appear as default in the airport modal)

How to create your own Report template

1. Go to **Reports > templates** option down the left-hand side of the page (you can also view/edit all your templates here)
2. Click on **add** to create a new template
3. Name the template
4. Choose the focus area (country, airspace or airport- note that the AC-U-Kwik data will only show for airport reports)
5. Choose the desired configuration from the tick box options (all the AC-U-Kwik data will now appear in the options)
6. *Set the template as a default by selecting the default template tick box*
7. Click **save** (the template will now appear in the modal dropdown on the reports dashboard)
