Introduction

The Risk Manager platform is designed to consolidate and streamline the security risk management process followed by aviation operators. Through providing up-to-date risk scoring (provided by Osprey) and facilitating the review of locations, you will be able to respond to global developments and make operational decisions faster. The platform also enables active monitoring of controls and the communication of key security information to stakeholders.

Selecting a location listed in the side panel of the dashboard will open the Overview Panel for a location.



THEMES & CONTROLS

Themes & Controls Tab The Themes & Controls tab is displayed as default when a location overview is accessed. It can be accessed from the tab bar within the overview panel by clicking the 'Themes & Controls' option, if you have navigated away from it.

Themes Table List of themes and their scores specific to the location being viewed. This provides you with a 'profile' for the types of risk present/most prevalent for the location.

Edit Theme Score Clicking this option will allow you to manually override the Osprey provided Theme Score with your own.

History Tab The History tab is accessed from the tab bar within the overview panel by clicking the 'History' option.

Generate Audit Report

Clicking this option will generate an Audit Report. This is an extract of the actions in the history table for the location.

CONTROLS



Accessed via the 'Controls' option in the navigation bar. The Controls Page allows you manage which Controls are available for use in the Dashboard.

Client Controls Library

This is the curated list of controls that are available for use by users of your account in the Dashboard. By curating the list here, you reduce the number of controls available for use (to make them easier to find) and ensure that controls not used by your organisation are not present for application.

More Information Clicking this option will expand the table row with further information for the control.





Create from Template

Clicking this option will open up a form to allow you to select a Control Template to use with the option to edit it prior to adding it to your Controls Library.

Add New Control

Clicking this button will allow you to create your own custom controls. You may wish to do this if the control you need isn't already present in the Osprey Template Library.

Edit Control

Clicking this option will open up the edit form so you can update the control details.

Delete Control

Clicking this option will remove the control from your companys control library and it will no longer be applied or available to apply to locations in the dashboard.

Customise Page

Clicking this navigation menu option will navigate you to the Customise page where Report Templates and Custom Elements can be configured.

Report Templates Tab Templates can be viewed created, edited and deleted in the Report

edited and deleted in the Report Templates tab.

Location Type Filter

Selecting a filter option will filter the table of results to only display reports that apply to the selected Location Type.

Osprey Supplied Templates

Osprey supply you with a standard template for each location type so that Location Summary Reports can be generated 'out of the box'. Osprey Templates cannot be edited or deleted.



Custom Elements Tab

Custom Elements can be viewed created, edited and deleted in the Custom Elements tab. Custom Elements display in Location Overviews and are also available as elements for inclusion in Report Templates.

Create New Template

Selecting this option will open up a form for you to be able to create and configure a new custom Report Template.

Report Template Search

Report Templates can be searched for by 'Template Name' using the search field.

Delete Report Template

Selecting this option will delete the Custom Report Template.

Edit Report Template

Selecting this option will open up a form for you to be able to edit the configuration of an existing custom Report Template.

To help you understand how to use the Risk Manager platform, below is a highlevel suggested workflow:

- Access the Risk Manager Dashboard and review which locations display in the 'Needs Review' section
- Select a location to review 2.
- 3. If action is required to mitigate the risk (I.e., reduce the Untreated Risk Score to an acceptable level):
 - a) Set workflow status to 'In Progress'
 - Review Theme scores (update them if you disagree with Ospreys scoring) b)
 - Review the Untreated Risk Score for the location (update if you disagree with C) the aggregated score)
 - Review the analysis and additional information for the location (update the additional information section if you have further information to add)
 - Apply or update the applied Controls to the location e)
 - Assess how the applied controls mitigate the risk
 - Update the Control Factor value by which to reduce the Untreated Risk Score g)
 - Observe the calculated Treated Risk Score based on the Control Factor Value h) input
 - Once happy with the Treated Risk Score, either set workflow status to 'Awaiting' i) Approval' (if approval required) OR set workflow status to 'Up to date'. If action is not required to mitigate the risk, set workflow status to 'Up to date'.

CONTROLLING RISK



The Treated Risk Score (TRS) value and the associated Level of Risk is the score that determines whether you are willing to operate at or within a location.

The TRS is calculated by subtracting the Control Factor (CF) value from the Untreated Risk Score (URS) value.

If the TRS is not at an acceptable value/level to allow you to operate at or within a location, this should prompt you to review the control measures you have applied, make some changes to the applied controls and formulate a Control Factor value based on how effective you believe the applied controls mitigate the risk for the location concerned in order to bring the TRS to a more acceptable level.



Glossary









Osprey has decided to use a standard set of terminology within the Risk Manager platform for consistency. Some organisations may use other synonyms for these terms and in some cases certain terminology will be new to an organisation.

To help you understand below is a brief glossary of key terminology used within the Risk Manager Platform.

Terminology	Meaning	Synonyms
Untreated Risk Score (URS)	This is the raw score for a location (by default, as an aggregation of the locations Theme Scores).	Risk Score, Risk Rating
Control Factor (CF)	This is the value specified by a user as to how much (or what factor), based on their assessment/analysis of a location and the controls applied, the URS is reduced by to produce a Treated Risk Score	-
Treated Risk Score (TRS)	This is the amended risk score for a location, if a CF has been specified the TRS will be calculated by subtracting the CF from the URS.	Controlled Risk Score
Control	This is a measure/action that can be applied to mitigate the level of risk whilst operating within a location.	Risk Mitigation Measure, Recommendation, Advice
Theme	A category of risk present within a type of location.	Risk Category, Risk Definition
Risk Score	A score produced for a location that takes in to account the current risk environment,	Risk Rating
Risk Scale	The absolute upper and lower values used to define the total number from which risk scores are calculated,	-
Risk Level	A specified boundary within a risk scale that has a level of risk assigned (i.e. Low, Medium High).	-
